Addendum for Parents/Coaches/Advisors Coaching Your Student through the Discovery Process

To maximize your student's experience with *Career Direct*®, we encourage you to explore the following steps together.

- 1. Pray for wisdom and direction from the Holy Spirit.
- 2. Request from your student the login and password for his or her Career Direct® account.*

 - Click on several of the occupations in the top Interests groups to automatically connect with O*NET. (Note: there are more occupations than the nine on the report.)
 Click on <u>MORE</u> to connect with O*NET for the remaining occupations in each of the top Interests groups. O*NET is the most up-to-date information on all occupations from the U.S. Department of Labor.
 - 1. The Career Direct® Reports and Action Plan contain Christian-oriented jobs which are linked to the most similar secular occupations in O*NET.
 - Explore the O*NET information on occupations of interest: Tasks, Knowledge, Skills, Abilities, Work Activities, Work Context, Job Zone (experience, training, examples, education), Interests, Work Styles, Work Values, Wages.
